

Minutes-Greer Co. Board of Commissioners held 10/26/20 at 9:00 a.m. Advance notice was filed in the office of the County Clerk on 10/23/20 and notice was posted on north entrance door of courthouse building & Greer Co. Commissioners' Office.

Present: Terry Nickell, Chairman; Steven Fite, Vice-Chairman; Brent York, Member; and Leanne Coffman, County Clerk.

Guests present: Sheriff Jackie Jenkins; Zach Maxwell, Editor, Mangum Star; Mary Jane Scott, Mayor; Scott Paxton, Mangum Chief of Police; Gary Ford, Chairman 911 Board; Jerry Nelson, Jail Advisory Board Member; and Debi Davis, Election Board Secretary.

Chairman Nickell called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

There was no action taken on Item #2.

Steven Fite made motion to meet with Mayor Mary Jane Scott and Chief of Police Scott Paxton. Brent York seconded the motion. Fite-Aye; York-Aye; Nickell-Aye. No nay votes. All were in favor and motion carried. Mayor Scott discussed the issues with the dispatcher helping the jailers and various other issues related to dispatch. The City is still looking at moving the Police Dept. and dispatch out of the Jail. There was also some discussion as to who should be helping with the dispatcher's salaries.

Brent York made the motion to meet with Sheriff Jackie Jenkins. Steven Fite seconded the motion. Fite-Aye; Nickell-Aye; York-aye. No Nay Votes. All were in favor and motion carried. Sheriff Jenkins gave an update on what the Sheriff's Dept. has been dealing with for the last week. Currently there is enough staffing for the jail. Sheriff Jenkins also stated that they are still having numerous problems in the County. Loose cattle and night hunting are currently the two biggest problems.

Steven Fite made the motion to approve the Transfer of Funds from the Highway M&O Account to the Highway Retirement Account. Brent York seconded the motion. York-Aye; Fite-Aye; Nickell-Aye. No Nay Votes. All were in favor and motion carried.

Brent York made motion to discuss updating and implementing the COVID-19 Policy and Procedures. Steven Fite seconded the motion. Fite-Aye; Nickell-Aye; York-aye. No Nay Votes. All were in favor and motion carried. At this time no definite action will be taken. Item to be placed on next week's agenda.

At the round table meeting Debi Davis, Election Board Secretary requested that each office receive a copy of the agenda each week. Ms. Davis also stated that each of the polling places will be fully staffed and will be sanitized before Election Day. Ms. Davis also asked if it would be okay to place a sign at the North Entrance of the Courthouse stating that the entrance would be used for Voter and Handicap access only on October 29th and 30th. The BOCC stated that they did not have an issue with the sign, but there was no way to enforce the restricted access.

There were no P.O.'s to approve for payment.
