

Minutes-Greer Co. Board of Commissioners held 2/24/20 at 9:00 a.m. Advance notice was filed in the office of the County Clerk at 8:20 a.m. on 2/21/20 and notice was posted on north entrance door of courthouse building & Greer Co. Commissioner's office.

Present: Terry Nickell, Chairman; Steven Fite, Vice-Chairman; Brent York; Leanne Coffman, County Clerk and Commissioners' Secretary, Jessica Wetsel.

Guests present: William Carroll, Editor, Mangum Star; Sheriff Jackie Jenkins and Verlin Wootton.

Chairman Nickell called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Steven Fite made the motion to meet with Verlin Wootton regarding road maintenance. Brent York seconded the motion. Nickell-Aye; York-Aye; Fite-aye. No nay votes. All were in favor, motion carried. Mr. Wootton was present to discuss what can/will be done on the county line road to his property. Chairman Nickell explained that he had been in contact with Beckham County District #2 Commissioner, Tate Finnell, and that they would be addressing the problems in the near future.

Brent York made the motion to meet with Sheriff Jackie Jenkins. Steven Fite seconded the motion. Nickell-Aye; York-Aye; Fite-aye. No nay votes. All were in favor, motion carried. Under New Business further cleanup of the Fair Grounds was mentioned. There is still some debris from the tornado. Chairman Nickell stated that his crew recently picked up and hauled off quite a bit. Hiring a grant writer was also discussed. After talking to ADA Dan Jacobsma and Dale Frech, ACCO it has been determined that the grant writer would need to supply the tools of his trade to be considered as an Independent Contractor. Chairman Nickell suggested that if Mr. Phil Paxton was still willing to work as a grant writer that he and ADA Dan Jacobsma both attend a meeting and see what sort of contract can be drawn up.

Under Roads/Bridges the Chairman Nickell stated that work on a bridge over Tittle Creek was slated to start next week. The Commissioners also discussed who should apply for a road or bridge project for 2025. The Commissioners also discussed and addressed complaints on some of the County Roads and what should and could be done to fix them.

Steven Fite made the motion to adjourn. Brent York seconded. York-Aye; Fite-Aye; Nickell-Aye. No Nay Votes. All were in favor and motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 10:12 a.m.
