Minutes - Greer Co. Board of Commissioners held on 6/29/2026 at 9:00 a.m. Advance notice posted on north entrance door of courthouse building & Greer Co. Commissioner's office, 6/25/2026.

Present: Mark Barnes, Chairman; Steven Fite, Vice-Chairman; Brent York, Member; County Clerk, Tiffany Buchanan & Shelby Monroe, Commissioners' Secretary.

Mark Barnes called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.
